It manages voluntary contributions paid into a trust by liquefied natural gas companies QGC Pty Limited, ConocoPhillips (Australia Pacific LNG) and Santos (Gladstone LNG). The Public Trustee of Queensland is the Trustee of the trust and has the ultimate responsibility for the investment and distribution of foundation funds.

The Foundation aims to ensure there is sufficient social infrastructure to meet the needs of the region's growing population, enhance the liveability of Gladstone communities, and help build more stable workforces.
